





Various points were discussed and the following decisions are taken in the meeting:

1. **Question Bank for Students:** Every faculty members have to provide the question bank (Multiple choice, Short answer, long answer) with solution to students of their concerned subjects.
2. **Subject Allotment:** Subject allotments for even semester has to be completed by the HoD. by January 12, 2022.
3. **Academic alendar:** Academic calendar has to be prepared by the Dean Academic Affairs by January 12, 2022.
4. **Revision by HoD/ Sr. Faculty:** HoD/ Sr. faculty member will revise the subject for first year students.
5. **Value added Course:** At least one Value added course related to employability, which can increase the analytical ability and I.Q of students has to be conducted in each year
6. **Conduct of Online classes:** As per the AKTU Letter Ref. No. AKTU/ Camp office/2022/12174 Dt. 9-1-2022 all the classes will be conducted in online mode from 10 January 2022 to 16 January 2022. However, exams will be conducted as usual.
7. A committee of all HoDs and Registrar is constituted to finalise the agenda of FC meeting and BOG meeting
8. A committee of all HoDs, Registrar and Dean Academic Affairs is constituted to explore the way out to increase the number of seats/ inclusion of new branch in the college.
9. **Basic Medical Kit:** In view of COVID19 situation it is decided to keep basic kit (1 per 10 students/faculty/staff) in the college as per the guidelines of the Doctor
