Various points were discussed in details and following decisions were taken:

- 1. Conduction of classes through on line mode for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students: In pursuance to the Notice No 1126/DAA/REC/2021 Dt. 8/4/2021 college tried its level best to conduct the classes in offline mode but most of the students did not turn up as per their schedule. However due to increase cases of COVID-19 and gathering of people due to election related training programme in the college premises, it is decided that with effect from 15 April 2021 classes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students will be conducted in online mode. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students have to vacate their hostel by 15 April 2021. In case these students have any problem they can contact their respective HoD.
- 2. Conduction of classes in offline and online mode for 4th year students: As per the discussion with the final year student, classes of final year students will be conducted through offline and online mode. All the students who are staying in the hostel have to attend the offline classes only. If any student is willing to attend online classes, he/ she has to vacate the hostel by 15 April 2021. In case these students have any problem they can contact their respective HoD.
- 3. Covid 19 Guidelines: All concerned and students needs to ensure social distancing and strict compliance of Government guidelines regarding COVID-19 during their stay in the college premises otherwise disciplinary action may be initiated.
